


Culture/Art and Design

These pictures are printed on fabric using block printing methods.


With your teacher you could learn how to design and print a fabric like this one.

These are warriors dressed in their Ceremonial dress


The figures are made of wood and varnished a beautiful colour


Would you like to do some painting and use similar colours?
