Ideas from our teacher in Uganda


- Do some local volunteering - children could visit people in hospital to sing songs, or hold a litter-picking morning at the local trading centre
- Hold a circle time where each child talks about someone they know who is caring.
- Who cares for you? Make thank you cards and give them to someone who cares for you. It could be a parent, relative, teacher or friend.
- Have a little picnic - everyone brings something small to share with the group

Sharing - in Uganda the children have few toys but they have such fun in using what is available and sharing with each other. One of the games the children play is using bottle tops and playing a game like draughts and they have a good time sharing with each other. Music is also important and the children share their musical instruments, drums and shakers which often their father makes for them.



The children at St. Zoe's and the Good Shepherd are very aware of their environment and the need to take care of all the resources available in a careful way. The children learn to plant seeds and watch the crops grow. The children at the Good Shepherd school have just become involved in fish husbandry. They now have a pond at the school and look after the fish. The fish also provides a good source of protein for them to eat.
